How many people are needed for Death in Venice?

Death in Venice is for 5 to 9 players. Someone needs to coordinate and organize (host) the game – they can either be in addition to the other players, or they can play one of the characters themselves. The step-by-step guide explains which characters to omit if you have fewer than 9 players (you do need at least 5, however). Here's how this works:

Number of players	Male characters	Female characters	Characters that can be played by anyone

And if you have even more guests, we have a few free extra characters for **Death in Venice** available on our website.

How does Death in Venice work?

Death in Venice runs for three or four hours and suits a buffet meal. The host can either play the role of the Chief Steward (game coordinator), or if they prefer they can instead play one of the characters. In either case, they are responsible for making sure everything runs smoothly and that all guests

have the information they need. The Chief Steward does not count toward the minimum or maximum number of players.

The characters are all confined on board the *Casanova*, to try and identify the murderer of Clay McFarland. They each have their own goals, and how they achieve these goals is up to them. *Death in Venice* is an evening of film-festival fury, movie-making misbehavior, and murder!

Playing online

Death in Venice has been designed to be particularly straightforward to adapt for play online, via video chat. The game includes instructions for how to use it in this way.

What happened yesterday

Around 1000: the *Casanova* anchored in Venice lagoon. It is too big to come close in to the harbor, so travel to and from the city is via small boats. It has one dinghy itself, which any of the passengers can pilot: and also water-taxis can be summoned at any time.

1000–1900: various people went to run personal errands in the city, but most stayed aboard the yacht.

2000: everyone traveled from the *Casanova* into the city to attend the film festival awards and gala dinner.

0000: the dinner event finished.

0100: by this time, everyone except Clay (who had decided to remain in the city for more drinking) was back on board the *Casanova*. The crew retired for the night; so, after this time, it is not known who may have gone from the yacht to the city, or vice versa, whether by dinghy or by water-taxi.

0430–0500: at some point in this period, Clay was killed, in St Mark's Square in the centre of the city.

0715: Clay's body was found. The police investigation started.

Now: Clay's death has been linked to the *Casanova*, traces of his blood have been found in its dinghy, and everyone has been confined to their cabins.
